ST JOHN'S (RASTRICK) PANTOMIME AUDITIONS FOR CAST AND CHORUS

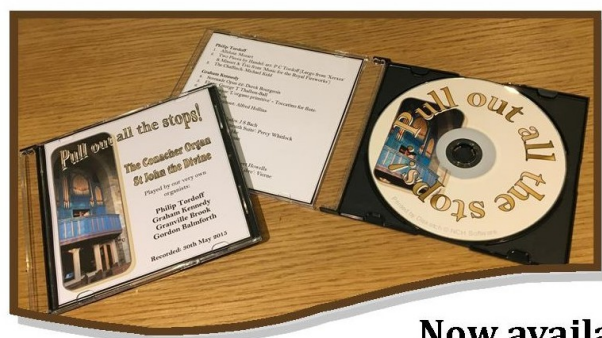

The walk is approx. 4.5 miles with some steep climbs but this does give some lovely far reaching views over Halifax and it's environs. We'll be going some nice bits of woodland and following a couple of babbling brooks which are very pleasant.

Directions – from Rastrick go up to the Sun Inn traffic lights and then up the hill to Ainley Top. At the roundabout take the 2nd exit towards the M62 but go under the motorway and take the 1st exit at the next roundabout to Blackley. Go through the village and down the hill, at the crossroads at the bottom turn left (signposted Holywell Green).

Follow the road down into the dip by the Rock Hotel and as you then go up again there are some brick bungalows for the elderly on your left (appropriately called St Helens) and the entrance to the park is immediately at the top of those bungalows through the yellow metal gate.

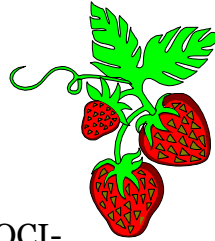
