Introduction to the Course

The Prayer Course has been created by 24-7 Prayer.

24-7 Prayer began as one simple prayer meeting in 1999, and is now an international, interdenominational movement, reviving the church and rewiring the culture through non-stop night and day prayer.

Using the Lord's Prayer as a basis we will explore prayer using the following topics with practical examples that help us to pray.

Session 1: Adoration: “Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name” – How can we enjoy God’s presence in praise and worship?

Session 2: Petition & Intercession “Give us this day our daily bread” - unpacking the significance of asking God in prayer.

Session 3: Unanswered Prayer “Your will be done” - tackling the challenges and realities when our prayers aren’t answered.

Session 4: Listening - “Give us this day our daily bread” - practical ways we can tune into hearing God’s voice.

Session 5: Spiritual Warfare “Deliver us from evil” - the ways we can pray God’s kingdom come in the midst of a spiritual battle.
